**Luke 19:8-10 (NCV)** “Zacchaeus stood and said to the Lord, ‘I will give half of my possessions to the poor. And if I have cheated anyone, I will pay back four times more.’<sup>9</sup> Jesus said to him, ‘**Salvation** has come to this house today, because this man also belongs to the family of Abraham.’<sup>10</sup> **The Son of Man came to find lost people and save them.’ ”**
